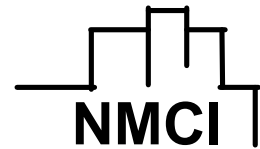

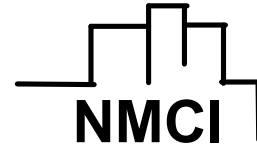
### CERTIFICATES:
